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Tickets are Going Fast for The Great Wine & Food Symposium!

(Grand Rapids, MI, February 13, 2008) On Friday, February 29 from 7:30 – 10 p.m., WGVU and D&W Fresh Market present West Michigan's premier wine tasting event at The Public Museum in Grand Rapids. Guests will choose from more than 300 international wine selections from France, Germany, Italy, Australia, Spain, Greece, Israel and other areas of the world. In addition, they will tempt their tastes with over 25 tables of select gourmet foods provided by D&W Fresh Market. Attendees will enjoy these tastes as classical music by professional performers drifts through the halls. The event also includes 20-40% discounts on wines ordered during the evening.
